Subject: Funding pattern for 8 North-Eastern States, 3 Himalayan States and Union Territories under AMRUT Scheme.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to this Ministry's O.M. No. 1455/FD-II/FD/2016 dated 16.02.2016 (Copy Enclosed with enclosures) on the above subject and to say that funding pattern under AMRUT for 8 North-Eastern States, 3 Himalayan States and all UTs has been revised as under:-

Sl. No.	States/UTs	Funding Pattern for Projects
1	8 North-Eastern States and 3 Himalyan States (J&K, Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand)	90% Central Assistance
2	All Union Territories	100% Central Assistance

2. The Central Assistance in State Annual Action Plan for year 2015-16 under AMRUT has already been communicated to States/UTs vide this Ministry's OM dated 31.07.2015. The Central Assistance indicated in the OM will count towards the central share and States/UTs will be required to provide their share in accordance with funding pattern. As an example for Jammu & Kashmir, the Central Assistance in SAAP 2015-16 will be Rs.153.87 Cr., State/ULB share Rs. 17.10 Cr. which brings the SAAP size to Rs. 170.97 Cr. As already indicated that State/UT may consider to provide enhanced State/ULB component so as to SAAP size may go up by upto 2%. A table showing Central Assistance Earmarked for 2015-16, sharing pattern and SAAP size is attached for above category of States/UTs.


**Office Memorandum**

With reference to the above, a clarification on the funding pattern of core schemes of the Ministry of Urban Development for North-Eastern States and three Himalayan States was sought from Dept. of Expenditure. Dept. of Expenditure vide their O.M. No.66(01)/PF-II/2015(Pt.V) dated 05.02.2016 (copy enclosed) has clarified that for AMRUT, Smart Cities Mission, JNNURM (subsumed in AMRUT) and SBM (Urban), the funding patterns for 8 North Eastern States and 3 Himalayan States would be 90:10. Further, the above schemes would be funded 100% by Centre in all Union Territories.

2. IFD's O.M. No.1455/FD-II/FD/2015 dated 18.11.2015 stands revised to the above extent. Programme Divisions may take necessary action accordingly.



Further, it is stated that all core and optional schemes should be funded 100% by Centre in all Union Territories (*para 4.52 of the Report of the Sub-Group*).


Please find attached the letter dated 28<sup>th</sup> October 2015 issued by Finance Secretary regarding Funding Pattern of Centrally Sponsored Schemes.

2. Please note that as already announced in the Budget and implied by para 6, the revised funding pattern is applicable w.e.f. financial year 2015-16.
3. "90:10 for the North Eastern and Himalayan States" is a standalone phrase in parenthesis implying that all core schemes in these areas will be implemented on 90:10 sharing basis.
4. For other States, the funding pattern for core schemes will be 60:40, except a few components where existing Central share is less than this level, in which case the existing sharing pattern will continue.
5. Please ensure the expenditure in financial year 2015-16 is within the budgetary resource available through the Budget Estimate and the Supplementary Grants made available during the course of the year.
